

# June Growing Guide



The beginning of winter marks a slower pace in the garden. Melbourne's cool, wet climate means less watering and less growth. June jobs include mulching, weeding and doing some planning for your spring patch.

Now is also a great time for planting bare-root trees (including fruit trees, roses and ornamentals), and even considering a green manure crop to prepare empty beds for spring veggies.

## Seedlings to plant in June:

- Broad beans
- Endive
- Spring onion
- Onion
- Peas
- Spinach
- Cabbage
- Radish
- Lettuce
- Chamomile
- Sage
- Coriander
